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
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

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The Kentucky Women's Cancer Screening Program (KWCSPP) offers FREE breast and cervical cancer screenings. The program provides Mammograms and Pap tests and follow-up services, education and outreach to low income, eligible women. Once in the program, if a woman has an abnormal screening, the KWCSPP covers the cost of most diagnostic tests. If a pre-cancer or cancer is found, the program connects her to treatment through Medicaid's Breast and Cervical Cancer Treatment Program (BCCTP). The KWCSPP provides services through Kentucky's local health departments, community health clinics and other healthcare providers. A woman does not have to reside in the same county in which she receives services. Healthcare providers, please refer eligible women to a participating KWCSPP clinic/provider. 


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
